Hurricane Ian: A Juried Exhibition

Exhibiting: September 1- 30, 2023

We believe in the healing power of art. In the aftermath of Hurricane Ian, we have seen a great need for healing in our community. We are asking artists to create artwork about their experiences during or after the storm in any capacity. It may be stories of resilience or trauma or loss. It can evoke a wide range of emotions. It is meant to be cathartic and therapeutic and shareable, something everyone can relate to in some way.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY FEE:

An entry consists of 1 to 3 artworks. There is no entry fee for this exhibition.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRY:

All entries must be submitted online no later than August 7 at 5pm. No materials will be accepted at the Alliance – this exhibit is online entries only. Upload digital images of artwork in JPG or PNG format. File size limit is 5MB. Please name files as follows: ARTIST- NAME-TITLE-MEDIUM-DIMENSIONS.JPG

SPECIFICATIONS:

We are asking artists to submit 2D and 3D artwork using predominantly found objects and recycled materials collected after Hurricane Ian, or artwork expressing the artist's experiences during and after Hurricane Ian. All media will be accepted, such as paint, collage, photo, drawing, print, etc. Only original artwork will be accepted. No giclée.

All 2D artwork must be wired and ready to hang and not exceed six feet in any direction. All 3D artwork must not exceed six feet in any direction or 150 lbs.

LIABILITY

If artwork is juried in, artists are responsible for all shipping costs. Every effort will be made to handle with care, including protection from loss. Alliance for the Arts will not be liable for loss or damage caused or occurring while work is exhibited or during shipping. The Alliance for the Arts reserves the right to photograph artwork for publicity purposes. Accepted artwork that is not picked up within 30 days of the end of the exhibition will henceforth be considered to belong to the Alliance for the Arts. Submission of any artwork constitutes an agreement to all conditions of this entry form, including schedule and permission to photograph for publicity purposes. Signature on the entry form is an agreement to these conditions.

SALES

All submitted works selected for inclusion and display during this exhibition must be offered for sale to the public at a labeled price set by the artist. A 40% commission will be retained by the Alliance for the Arts on all work sold during the exhibition.

Drop off Accepted Work: August 28, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.
